This system aims to manage anti-corruption targets, establish procedures to prevent and confront illicit practices, analyze the risks inherent in the activities carried out, and implement and supervise corruption control measures.

In order to prohibit any form of corruption, Cascais Dinâmica promotes awareness among all stakeholders, acting preventively and actively with an ethical commitment to guide the actions of its employees, applying all the necessary resources to this end. It also encourages the expression of concerns, referenced in good faith or based on solid convictions, aiming to guarantee confidentiality and protection against potential reprisals.

In addition, it ensures strict compliance with applicable anti-corruption laws and the voluntary commitments associated with its activities, promoting agreement and continuous improvement of the Anti-Corruption Management System through the involvement of all employees, thus guaranteeing its operational effectiveness.

This system fosters a culture of ethics, integrity and compliance at Cascais Dinâmica. In this way, and in response to the system's requirements and the anti-corruption legislation in force, a person responsible for regulatory compliance has been appointed, with decision-making autonomy, functional independence and adequate resources to ensure compliance with the Anti-Corruption Management System.
