How can I find out if I am registered and what's my voter number?	You can get this information, even on election day: At the parish council of your place of residence; Via SMS text message (free of charge) sent to 3838 with the message "RE (space) Citizen's card / ID card number (space) date of birth = yyyymmdd". For example: "RE 7424071 19820803"; On the Internet at www.recenseamento.mai.gov.pt.
